

# Plein Air Drawing & Painting Workshop

*with Ashley Frost*

This three hour workshop with Ashley Frost is for students with an interest in drawing and painting outdoors who would like to improve their skills. The workshop will focus on setting up your composition as well as observing and recording the tonal range, colour and gesture of the landscape. With a good understanding of tone and light you can bring atmosphere, distance and mood into your landscape drawing and painting. You can choose to draw using pencil or charcoal; or paint using watercolour, guache, acrylic or oils. **Drawing pads and charcoal pencils will be available or you can choose to bring your own drawing and/or painting materials.**

At 5pm you will meet at the Clifton School of Arts where you will do some preparation work and your tutor will give you an introduction to the workshop. You will also be able to see a selection of Ashley's paintings in the current CSA exhibition. At 530pm you set up in the park directly across the road from the gallery. Students will produce several landscape studies and learn the techniques of observing light. Ashley will do a brief painting demonstration and provide individual guidance. If you are running late you can go directly to the park and in the event of inclement weather the workshop will take place in the gallery.
